# VISITING SHOOTER'S DECLARATION

## Non-FAC Holders

Please read carefully the following paragraph before signing

It is an offence for someone who is prohibited by Section 21 of the 1988 Firearm Amendment Act to have a firearm or ammunition in his/her possession at any time. Section 21 applies to anybody who has been sentenced to imprisonment or youth custody or detention in a young offenders institution for three months or more. The period which they are prohibited depends on the length of sentence – if the sentence was longer than three years, the prohibition is for life. If the sentence was three months or more, but less than three years, the prohibition lasts for five years from the date of release. It is an offence for a person to transfer, let or hire, give or lend a firearm or ammunition to someone he/she knows or has reasonable ground for believing to be prohibited by Section 21 of the 1988 Firearm Amendment Act.
